



## Dabbling Birder Team To-Do List

A team consists of one to five individuals.

- All adult team members have read the rules ([linked here](#)), registered for the Birding Bowl and at least 1 adult (18 or older) is on the team.
- All members of your team observed (saw or heard) 20 or more different bird species in May. *All team members must be birding together for the birds to count. You can bird with other teams.*
- Your team attended one Nebraska Bird Month program ([in-person](#) or [recorded here](#)).
- Your team submitted five or more eBird checklists with at least one location listed on the [Nebraska Birding Guide map](#).
  - Checklists included your team name in the comments section
  - Checklists were shared with the “NEBirdingBowl-dabbling” account
- After your team submitted their last competition checklist, one team member created a Trip Report with only your competition checklists (e.g., checklists in NE from May 1-31 2024).
  - Trip report narrative included 1) your team name, 2) names of adult team members, 3) name of the bird month program you attended & 4) one thing you learned from the program.
  - Trip Report link was emailed to [ngpc.birdingbowl@nebraska.gov](mailto:ngpc.birdingbowl@nebraska.gov) with the email subject: “Your Team Name - Dabbling Birder Trip Report” by June 6, 2024.

**Scoring:** Each team member that completes the Dabbling Birder requirements is entered into a drawing for a pair of Vortex Diamondback binoculars and a drawing for a 2-night cabin stay at Ponca or Niobrara State Parks.
